I am impressed and encouraged with the gender representation in Council. ANC and EFF have 50% of women. I am encouraging other political parties to improve on gender representation.

Leadership is recognized through hard work, skills displayed in executing their responsibilities. MOLEMOLE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY COUNCIL RE-ELECTS MAYOR COUNCILLOR MASILO PAYA

Molemole Local Municipality officially inaugurated Cllr. Masilo Edward Paya as its new Mayor on Tuesday, 22 November 2021.

Cllr. Paya pledged his commitment to serving Molemole to loud applause and a standing ovation after the inaugural ceremony during the Council meeting.

"I continue as the Mayor of a Municipality that is financially sound and sustainable as per the latest audit outcome from the Auditor General of South Africa, and one that delivers a high standard of basic services; water, refuse removal and disposal, sewerage removal and treatment, electricity distribution and municipal road maintenance" said the Mayor.

This inaugural council meeting ushered in the new council of the municipality in which some councillors were not returned, while others were returned to continue with the business that they left behind in the previous term. The Council has thirty two (32) councillors; sixteen (16) of which are Ward councillors and the remaining sixteen (16) are PR councillors. These represents various political parties as follows: ANC twenty



two (22) seats; EFF six (06) seats, CICAF two (2) seats, CW one (1) seat and the DA one (01) seat. The Council also elected Executive Committee Chairpersons for Finance, Corporate Services, Technical Services, LED & Planning, Community Services and MPAC Chairperson.

Cllr. Paya, is one such public representative who is returned by his political party and was overwhelmingly, without being opposed, re-elected as the continuing Mayor of the municipality. This has become so handy that he will continue to implement the strategic plan that was carved at the end of the previous term. This was necessary and critical so that when the new term begins, time is never wasted.

This allowed the election of the political leadership of the municipality as provided for in the Structures Act and other relevant legislations. The Municipal Manager, Mr Maphala Mosena, presided over the election of the Speaker, Cllr. Dikeledi Matlou, who is fairly new in this role. The Speaker, after being inaugurated, proceeded to oversee the election of the new Mayor and the Chief Whip, Cllr. Masilo Rathaha, who were re-elected, to ensure compliance with the provisions of the Structures Act. The Speaker is responsible for ensuring oversight, accountability, integrity, the discipline of office and the efficient running of council meetings.

The newly elected Mayor, Cllr. Paya, was given the opportunity to address Council. He congratulated the new Speaker for her election and believed that, she will succeed in ensuring that her office diligently plays its oversight responsibilities. He further congratulated all sworn-in councillors, for agreeing to take an oath of allegiance to the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa and other related laws. He emphasised the need to heed the voters mandate to deliver basic services like water, electricity, housing, improved roads infrastructure, to name just a few. He showed great humbleness to once again be given an opportunity to be the political head of the municipality. "The previous council has indeed done a good job in trying to provide services to our people with excellence", said Mayor Paya.



Mayor Paya, emphasized that all these commitments, can only be achievable, if we work together as a united council, irrespective of our political affiliations. "Yes, we come from different political parties, but as a council we have to work together to advance the interest of the people of this municipality, said Cllr. Paya.

In conclusion, the Mayor said, Councillors must attend all of their respective portfolio meetings as assigned for an effective oversight over the administration. Officials of the municipality must not only observe their working hours, but they must also do their work diligently and to deservedly earn their salaries. We deserve a clean audit opinion and should forever strive for it, said the Mayor.





MOLETJIE SATELLITE OFFICE OFFICIALLY OPENED IN GA-PHAUDI

On Tuesday, December 14, 2021, Mayor, Cllr. Masilo Edward Paya officially opened Moletjie Cluster office. According to Paya, the opening of the office will enable the municipality to provide improved basic service delivery to the communities in the area.

The municipality intends to approach relevant government departments to promote the idea of Multipurpose Centres, which will provide services at the door step of the residents. This will serve as a catalyst for the much needed economic activities of the area. The Mayor urges the community to work together with Magoši and the Municipality to bring great this idea to fruition.

"The coordination of services and humanitarian events may also be managed from this venue, thus it becomes an important cog of service delivery," said Mayor Paya.

He added that the public must remember that delivery of basic services is municipality's main business; so all stakeholders, community, municipal entities, departments and businesses must consider at increasing their resilience.

Molemole Local Municipality is pulling no punches when it comes to the provision of basic services to its residents. The Mayor is grateful to Kgoši Kgabo Moloto III (wa boraro) of Moletjie Tribal Authority, for donating this piece of land to the municipality. "This is much considerate and caring for our people – Re tloga re leboga Mohlaloga", said the Mayor.

Cllr. Paya calls on the residents of Wards 10, 14, 15 & 16 to take care of this office, which was specifically built to serve them. There will be a team of officials that will be taking care of various service delivery needs such as - proof of residences, reports on water challenges, grading and road maintenance.

Mayor, Cllr. Masilo Edward Paya wished the residents of Molemole and all the visitors a Merry Christmas and a Prosperous 2022. The municipality will be providing all essential services during the festive season. Residents are advised to report all problems related to any of the services to their Ward Councilors. 

The aim of the session was to thank all Magoši of Molemole Local Municipality for the vital role they played during his tenure. In attendance was Kgoši Kgabo Moloto III, Kgoši Machaka, Kgoši Ratsaka, Kgoši Makgato and Provincial Chairperson of House of Traditional Leaders Kgoši Malesela Dikgale.

Mayor Paya pledged that the municipality will continue with the long-standing good relationship that it has always enjoyed with Magoši. "I am grateful to have worked together with you (Magoši) in ensuring that services are rendered to our communities, because without you it would have been difficult for the municipality to reach communities out there," he said.

Amongst the issues of service delivery that the municipality has successfully executed, is the completion of the road linking Kgwadu Primary School to Botlokwa Primary School, Design and Construction of 1500 seater grandstand and ancillary works at Mohodi Sports Complex, Upgrading of Capricorn Park and Nthabiseng internal streets from gravel to surfacing phase 3 & 4.



Other challenges that the municipality is facing includes lack of water. The Mayor has indicated that the new Council is faced with a mammoth task of providing basic services to the communities. He committed himself to making sure that the issues raised by the traditional leaders will be looked into by the current Council. Kgoši Moloto III commended the municipality under the leadership of his Worship Cllr. Paya. "We are very pleased to be part of this important gathering, where the Mayor is giving us feedback on issues relating to service delivery. Based on previous interactions, we now understand how the municipality operates. We understand that there are challenges, but we are happy that we are informed on how those service delivery challenges are being addressed", said Kgoši Moloto III.

The Municipal Manager, Mr. Maphala Mosena, together with his team of Senior Managers, was given an opportunity for the presentation of certificates of appreciation to outgoing councilors. The Mayor presented the certificates to all the outgoing councilors. MAYOR HANDS OUT FOOD PARCELS TO THE DESTITUTE COMMUNITIES OF MOLEMOLE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY.

As part of the outreach programme, the Mayor of Molemole Local Municipality, Cllr. Masilo Edward Paya, handed out food parcels to destitute families within the jurisdiction of our municipality. Such families, the needy and destitute, were identified by Ward Councillors.

With the help from one of the biggest banking institutions in South Africa, Nedbank, through its social responsibilities, facilities were made available to enable the municipality to take care of the destitute within its jurisdiction. The Mayor was able to hand out the food parcels to about one hundred (100) needy families in all the wards of the municipality, whose households were affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. "It is our take as the leadership of the municipality that it is critical and of utmost importance for banks not to be known for only charging us to banking with them, but that they are also involved in the eradication of poverty by helping those in need. We salute Nedbank and hope and believe that other such institutions and many others will come on board and be part of this municipality in its programs meant to provide for the destitute", said Mayor Paya.

To many of these families, it was an early Christmas present and they were grateful to the municipality for having identified them as recipients of the food parcels. All the Ward Councillors and other officials accompanied the Mayor in the execution of this good and noble course.

"I do note the negative reality of many people who have been affected by this unforeseen pandemic. Even though most industries have returned to normal operation, the need for assistance remains even under level one as per the Disaster Regulations, and we have filled in the gaps wherever possible through the distribution of food relief to residents in need," said Paya.

He says the municipality is working hard to drive local economic recovery and will need the support of the residents and other stakeholders in this drive to accomplish it.

"We overcame the worst of the Covid-19 pandemic together, but we cannot become complacent. As we work towards rebuilding our economy and lives, continued recovery depends on all of us; our responsibility is not over yet. It is vital that we continue to take the necessary precautions," he said.



MOLEMOLE MUNICIPALITY MASS VACCINATION OUTREACH PROGRAMMES

With the rise in the availability of the COVID-19 Vaccines, communities in the Molemole Local Municipality can now roll their sleeves up for a jab conveniently. This follows the successful launch of Covid-19 Vooma vaccination awareness campaigns locally.

As one of the Social Mobilization and Demand Creation approaches of the Limpopo Department of Health COVID-19 Vaccination Rollout strategy stipulates, vaccines need to be made accessible as much as possible. The municipality has heeded the call and has hit the ground running with numerous outreach programs in and around the Molemole area to make sure that majority of the population is well informed and confident enough to get vaccinated.


As part of the initiative, the Mass Vaccination Outreach Programmes in partnership with the Limpopo Department of Health held at the Botlokwa & Soekmekaar Taxi Ranks, showed great success and turnout, much to the Mayor's satisfaction. Although the municipality had already been playing a major role in carrying out the vaccine swiftly with the recent vaccination of the Mayor, Cllr. Masilo Edward Paya together with the Political Management Team (PMT) earlier this year, the journey to mass vaccination continues.

Molemole Local Municipality, the Limpopo Department of Health and various stakeholders have joined hands, to ease the mass vaccination process and have, with the call of the Limpopo MEC of Health, Dr. Poppy Ramathuba, expanded the vaccinations to primary health care facilities. As a result, Mohodi, Ga-Ramokgopa and Matoks Clinics have been declared permanent vaccination sites since September already. Citizens are now able to produce their Identity Documents, register onsite and immediately get their vaccine. This expansion is expected to positively contribute to the rise in vaccines which will eventually lead to our people being immune to the virus and ultimately fighting it off in case of infection.

Municipal Manager, Mr. Lazarus Mosena encourages all staff and community members to be inoculated as about 90% of its staff, including senior staff members have already been vaccinated. Vaccines continue to reduce a person's risk of contracting the COVID-19 virus and are highly effective in reducing hospitalization and fatalities. This though, does not substitute the need for a mask that covers both the mouth and nose as well as frequent hand washing with a soap and constant sanitizing. Mayor Paya, will continue to carry out his mandate to initiate, monitor and support drives and programs in the vaccination processes within the Molemole Local Municipality.
