Swemmers maak klub trots

Swemsensasies Lyndon Ferns en Chad le Clos het Suid-Afrika voorheen tydens die Olimpiese Spele verteenwoordig en deesdae is hulle menige jong swemmer se helde.

Twee plaaslike swemmers wat opkyk na dié twee is Katelyn Ferns (10) en Juan Randall (12), wat albei by Action Aquatics onder Ude Fuchs se wakende oog swem.

Tydens die Limpopo Kampioenskappe op 13 en 14 Februarie is Juan as junior Victor Ludorum aangewys nadat hy met nie minder as 10 goue medaljes weggestap het nie. Hy is ook aangewys as algehele swemmer van die dag.

“Ek swem reeds vandat ek ses jaar oud is en dit was lekker om soveel eerste plekke in te palm. Ek oefen elke weeksdag en ook elke tweede Saterdag. Dinsdae en Donderdae swem ek voor, en die ander dae, na skool. Party dae swem ek twee-en-'n-half tot drie ure en ander kere weer net 'n uur-en-'n-half. Ek geniet die galas die meeste en werk hard om goeie plekke te behaal.”

Juan sê vlinderslag is vir hom die maklikste en lekkerste, terwyl borsslag weer die

moelikste is.

Die oefeninge, veral wanneer hulle gedruk word, is vir hom die uitdagendste. Hy is ook deel van Ooskool se swemspan.

“Ek speel ook rugby, krieket en neem deel aan atletiek. My swemheld is Chad le Clos en ek wil graag in sy voetspore volg. My raad aan ander swemmers is om hard te oefen en te werk vir wat hulle wil hê.”

Katelyn is tydens dieselfde kampioenskappe as junior Victrix Ludorum, met ses goue medaljes aangewys. Sy sê swem is in haar bloed en haar swemhelde is haar pa, Gordon en 'oom Lyndon'. Sy swem reeds vanaf sesjarige ouderdom en geniet borsslag en vryslag die meeste.

“Ek oefen elke dag van die week en geniet die oefening die meeste. Alles van swem is vir my lekker en ek kan nie aan iets dink waarvan ek nie hou nie. Vlinderslag is wel vir my die moeilikste. My raad aan ander swemmers is om aan te hou oefen al is dit moeilik. Ons het 'n swembad by die huis en ek wys my niggies hoe om te swem.”

Die klub het tussen die 12 swemmers 23 goue-, 21 silwer- en 14 bronsmedaljes ontvang.

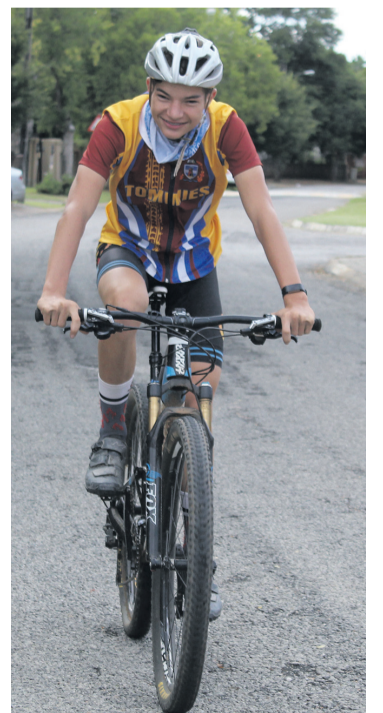
