Background

Molemole Local Municipality has earmarked the above-mentioned area for Development, which is currently underutilized (vacant Land). Mogwadi (Formerly Known as Dendron) is located 64 km North of Polokwane Municipality, along R521 Road which link Mogwadi to Botswana and Zimbabwe.

The Municipality hereby invites prospective Developers to submit their proposals for the development of a Shopping Complex and Related Commercial precinct, providing the full spectrum of amenities. The site covers 10.7800 hectares and well located on the corner of Republic Street & Polokwane- Alldays Road.
